Introduction of Southern Medical University

Established in 1951, Southern Medical University (SMU), a national key university (1979), was originally the First Military Medical University, PLA. In August 2004, it was handed over to the local government of Guangdong Province and renamed as Southern Medical University. It is the only Provincial Prospective High-Level Medical Universities and the first Ministry-Province Co-constructed Medical University. SMU is one of the first 8 prestigious universities to run the pilot 8-year medical education program. It is also the first universities to pilot the program of education and cultivation of outstanding doctors in China.

SMU, located at the foot of the picturesque Baiyun Mountain in Guangzhou, has two campuses. The main campus and the Shunde campus cover an area of nearly 1.70 million square meters, with a construction area of 1.144 million square meters.

SMU comprises 21 teaching institutions and currently has a total of 24,924 full-time students, including 9,522 postgraduates, 14,140 undergraduates, and 1,066 international students. SMU has 15 affiliated hospitals, among them, there are 11 Grade 3, Class A hospitals, with a combined total of over 22,000 beds. The annual patient volume reaches approximately 22 million cases.

SMU has doctoral and master's degree authorization qualifications in all medical disciplines, and 10 postdoctoral research mobile stations. It has 23 national-level first-class undergraduate professional construction points, leading the number of independent medical universities in China. SMU has formed a multidisciplinary system with Medicine as the mainstream, Science, Engineering, Law, Management and Education developing in a coordinated manner. Its 13 academic disciplines including Clinical Medicine, Pharmacology and Toxicology, Molecular Biology and Genetics, Biology and Biochemistry, Neuroscience and Behavioristics, Immunology, Chemistry, Materials Science, Microbiology, Social Science, Agricultural Science, Environmental and Ecology, Psychiatry/Psychology were listed by ESI (Essential Science Indicators) as the world's top 1%, among which Clinical Medicine was listed as the world's top 0.5 ‰, Pharmacology and Toxicology was listed as the world's top 1‰. In 2024 THE (Times Higher Education) World University Rankings, SMU ranked 351-400th globally and 1st among independent medical universities in China.

SMU has 2242 full-time teachers, including 330 national high-level talents such as academicians and a group of internationally renowned experts such as academicians of the Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences, the American Academy of Sciences, and the French Academy of Sciences as visiting professors. SMU has a number of top national teaching and research platforms such as State Key Laboratory, National Clinical Medical Research Center, National International Science and Technology Cooperation Base, National Innovation Talent Training Demonstration Base, etc. The number of projects established by the National Natural Science Foundation has ranked among the top 30 universities and scientific research institutions in China for 8 consecutive years, and the first place in independent medical universities. A series of research results have been published in top international journals such as Science, Cell, Nature, JAMA, NEJM and so on. SMU has won 33 national awards such as the National Natural Science Award,

the National Science and Technology Progress Award, and the National Technological Invention Award, and the number of awards ranks in the forefront among medical universities in China.

In 2005, the University began to enroll international undergraduates majoring in MBBS (Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery, programs delivered in English), and started to enroll international students who receive Chinese Government Scholarship in 2006. At the end of 2023, SMU has cultivated more than 2,900 international students from 114 different countries. Besides, SMU is one of the ten educational foreign aid bases designated by the Ministry of Education of China, and the key backbone unit of foreign aid training designated by the Ministry of Commerce of China. It has trained 3,329 medical and health officials and technicians from 125 countries.

SMU regularly conducts foreign exchanges and establishes friendly relations with 71 universities as well as medical and research institutions in 24 countries and regions, carrying out multi-channel cooperation activities such as jointly running schools, scientific research cooperation, jointly training students and teachers.

2024 Admission Guide for International Undergraduate Students of Southern Medical University (English Medium)

I. Admission Requirements

1. Applicants should be non-Chinese citizens holding a valid foreign passport.

If both parents or one of the parents of the applicant are Chinese citizens and reside in a foreign country, the applicant should have foreign nationality at birth and hold a valid foreign passport or nationality certificate for at least 4 years. In addition, a record of more than 2 years of actual residence in a foreign country in the last 4 years (by April 30, 2024) is also needed. For people immigrating from Chinese mainland, Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan to foreign countries and are applying as international students, please refer to the requirements above.

- 2. Applicants should be physically and mentally healthy, and meet the medical examination standards for applying for a study visa or residence permit in China.
 - 3. Applicants should be 18-30 years old with a high school diploma or above.
- 4. Applicants should be friendly to China, with excellent grades and good conduct, without any record of violation of school rules and regulations, nor any record of public security punishment or criminal record.
 - 5. Applicant's language proficiency must meet the following requirements:
- (1). Basic understanding of Chinese. Applicants should provide the certificate of basic Chinese learning, such as training certificate, HSK certificate, etc. Those without any Chinese language background must attend the Chinese training organized by the University before the enrollment;
- (2). Applicants from non-English-speaking countries must reach a score above 80 in TOEFL (15 or above for each item) or 6.0 in IELTS (5.5 or above for each item); or provide other comparable certificates proving English proficiency. Applicants from English-speaking countries or receiving the last degree with the instruction in English are exempt from submitting the English proficiency certificates, but the certificate of English medium issued by the school graduated from shall be provided.

II. Majors

1. MBBS

Southern Medical University is qualified to admit Clinical Medicine international undergraduate students (English medium) announced by the Ministry of Education of China. Since September 2005, SMU

has admitted more than 1,700 students from over 50 countries including India, Bangladesh, Mauritius, Pakistan, Thailand, Jordan, Kenya, Somalia, Iran, Zambia, United States, United Kingdom, South Korea.

Referring to the international standards for medical education, and the *Quality Control Specification of Medical Undergraduate Education for International Students in China (English Medium) (Trial)*, the program is carried out while giving due consideration to the medical needs of international students' source countries and the international needs of returning to home country or serving in a third country. The major aims at training international medical talents with solid basic knowledge, proficient clinical skills and good professional ethics, and devotes to providing medical, teaching and research personnel to medical and health services department. The main courses include Human Anatomy, Histology and Embryology, Physiology, Biochemistry, Pathology, Pharmacology, Microbiology, Immunology, Medical Diagnostics, Medical Psychology, Internal Medicine, Surgery, Gynecology and Obstetrics, Pediatrics, Epidemiology, etc..

The duration of study is six years including one year of internship in hospitals. International students will be awarded the degree of Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) in English.

2. BDS

The major aims to cultivate high-quality dental professionals who master the basic knowledge, theories and skills of basic medicine and clinical medicine, have professional knowledge and skills of dentistry, and are capable of diagnosis and treatment of common dental diseases. The main courses include Introduction of Dentistry, Dental Biology, Dental Anatomy and Physiology, Dental Histopathology, Imaging Diagnosis of Dental and Maxillofacial Medicine, Dental and Maxillofacial Surgery, Operative Dentistry and Endodontics, Periodontal Disease, Dental Mucosal Diseases, Pediatric Dentistry, Prosthodontics, Orthodontics, Preventive Dentistry, Dental Materials Science, Geriatric Dentistry, Dental Equipment, etc..

The duration of study is six years including one year of internship. International students will be awarded the degree of Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS).



V. Application Materials

- 1. Scanned copy of valid passport's information page;
- 2. Scanned copy of *Highest Academic Degree Certificate*, *Expected Graduation Certificate* for fresh graduates (original one and English-translated one. After being pre-admitted, applicants are required to submit final Graduation Certificate to be eligible for official admission.);
- 3. Scanned copies of transcript of all courses during the highest academic degree education (original one and English-translated one);
 - 4. ID photo (2-inch blue background photo without hats);
 - 5. Scanned copy of Foreigner's Physical Examination Form completed in Chinese or English;
 - 6. English self-introduction video (3-5 minutes, no more than 50M);
 - 7. Certificate of Language proficiency;
- 8. Financial Support Guarantee Statement and scanned copies of its supporting documents completed in Chinese or English, certifying that the applicant has sufficient funds to cover his or her tuition, accommodation, living expenses and international travels during his or her study in China. The minimum amount of funding required is RMB 150,000. Only one's relatives can act as his or her financial sponsor. The statement should be accompanied by a scanned copy of the financial sponsor's valid passport or identification certificate (self-supporting applicants should submit this statement);
- 9. Original *Authorization to the Guardian* (for self-supporting applicants under the age of 18 by September 1, 2024) needs to be notarized with signatures. If not notarized in China, the endorsement of local Chinese Embassy is required.
 - ★ Guardians shall be Chinese or foreign adults who reside in China with stable source of income.
 - ★ Graduation certificate and transcript should be notarized.
 - ★ The University will request for supplementary materials when necessary.
- ★ Application materials mentioned above will not be returned to applicants whether they are admitted or not.
 - ★ All the forms can be downloaded from the official website of School of International Education.

VI. Review and Admission

The University will review the completeness and authenticity of the applicant's materials, and organize entrance examination (written examination/interview) for qualified applicants.

- 1. Written examination
- (1) Examination subjects

English, Mathematics, Science Comprehensive (Physics, Chemistry, Biology)

The full score is 100 points and the examination time is 120 minutes.

- (2) Examination date: Starting from December 2023, it will be held on the 15th of each month.
- 2. Interview: The interview focuses on the applicant's overall quality and language communication skills.

The school will make a comprehensive assessment based on the results of the written exam and the interview, and will accept the applicants on the basis of merit. Those who do not pass the exam may apply for transferring to the Foundation program.

- ★ According to the actual situation, the information related to the examination may be adjusted, please pay attention to the website of the School of International Education and email notification.
- ★ The pre-admission results will be announced from January 2024. Applicants must prepay the deposit which is part of the tuition fee for confirmation within the deadline, otherwise the applicant will be deemed to give up the pre-admission qualification.
- ★ Applicants can check the result of admission on SMU International Students Management System, and the *Admission Notice* with an official seal of SMU will be sent afterwards.
- ★ Visa Application for Study in China (JW202) are fully electronic from 2023 onwards, and will be sent to the email address that the applicant has filled in on the application system. Please download it from your computer in time, as there are a total of 10 chances to download it.
- ★ After receiving the Admission Notice and Visa Application for Study in China (JW202), applicants shall apply for Study Visa in China to the Chinese Embassy (Consulate General) and other visa agencies with the following materials: Admission Notice, Visa Application for Study in China (JW202), the original copy and photocopy of Physical Examination Record for Foreigner and valid passport.

VII. Admission Date

Students should register in September 2024, and the specific time shall be subject to the date marked on the *Admission Notice*.

Admission Notice, Visa Application for Study in China (JW202), passport, certificate of physical

examination and other relevant materials in accordance with the prescribed time on the Admission Notice.

Students who cannot register on time due to certain reasons shall obtain prior consent of the University.

Those who fail to register within the given time without approval will be regarded as waiver of registration.

3. Accommodation fee (1 academic year counted as 10 months):



I. Admission Requirements

1. Applicants should be non-Chinese citizens holding a valid foreign passport.

If both parents or one of the parents of the applicant are Chinese citizens and reside in a foreign country, the applicant should have foreign nationality at birth and hold a valid foreign passport or nationality certificate for at least 4 years. In addition, a record of more than 2 years of actual residence in a foreign country in the last 4 years (by April 30, 2024) is also needed. For people immigrating from Chinese mainland, Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan to foreign countries and are applying as international students, please refer to the requirements above.

- 2. Applicants should be physically and mentally healthy, and meet the medical examination standards for applying for a study visa or residence permit in China.
 - 3. Age Limit and Education Background Requirements:
 - (1) Master's students: under the age of 35, with a degree comparable to the Bachelor's Degree in Chinese universities.
 - (2) Doctoral students: under the age of 40, with a degree comparable to the Master's Degree in Chinese universities.
 - (3) General Scholar: under the age of 45, with a degree comparable to the Bachelor's Degree in Chinese universities.
 - (4) Senior Scholar: under the age of 50, with a degree comparable to the Master's Degree in Chinese universities.
- 4. Applicants should be friendly to China, with excellent grades and good conduct, without any record of violation of school rules and regulations, nor any record of public security punishment or criminal record.
 - 5. Language Proficiency Requirements:

Chinese Medium Program: Applicants must reach a score above 180 in HSK 5 or provide other comparable certificates proving Chinese proficiency. Applicants receiving the last degree with the instruction in Chinese are exempt from submitting the Chinese proficiency certificates, but the certificate of Chinese medium issued by the school graduated from shall be provided;

English Medium Program: Applicants from non-English-speaking countries must reach a score above 90 in TOEFL (20 or above for each item) or 6.5 in IELTS (6.0 or above for each item); or provide other comparable certificates proving English proficiency. Applicants from English-speaking countries or receiving the last degree with the instruction in English are exempt from submitting the English proficiency certificates, but the certificate of English medium issued by the school graduated from shall be provided.

★Applicants for professional Master's Degree (General Scholars) in Clinical Medicine (1051), Dentistry (1052), Traditional Chinese Medicine (1057), and Nursing (1054) are required to provide a certificate of 180 points or above in HSK Level 5 (inclusive) or equivalent Chinese language proficiency upon admission. Graduation thesis must be written in Chinese (English translation version can be attached). For specific majors, please refer to Master's Degree (Professional) / General Scholars Programs of 2024 Degree Programs for International Master's /Doctoral Students (Visiting Scholars) of Southern Medical University.

★ Applicants for academic Doctoral/Master's Degree (Senior Scholars) in Clinical Medicine (1002) and Dentistry (1003) are required to provide a certificate of 180 points or above in HSK Level 4 (inclusive) or equivalent Chinese language proficiency upon admission. For specific majors, please refer to Doctoral/Master's Degree (Academic) / Visiting Scholars Programs of 2024 Degree Programs for International Master's /Doctoral Students (Visiting Scholars) of Southern Medical University.



V. Application Materials

- 2. Scanned copy of *Highest Academic Degree Certificate*, *Expected Graduation Certificate* for fresh graduates (original one and English-translated one. After being pre-admitted, applicants are required to submit final Graduation Certificate to be eligible for official admission.);

 - 6. Provisional Acceptance Letter from a professor of Southern Medical University;
 - 7. List and abstracts of published papers or other materials demonstrating research abilities;
 - 8. ID photo (2-inch blue background photo without hats);
 - 9. English or Chinese self-introduction video (3-5 minutes, no more than 50M);
 - 10. Scanned copy of Foreigner's Physical Examination Form completed in Chinese or English;

- 11. Certificate of language proficiency;
- 12. Financial Support Guarantee Statement and scanned copies of its supporting documents completed in Chinese or English, certifying that the applicant has sufficient funds to cover his or her tuition, accommodation, living expenses and international travels during his or her study in China. The minimum amount of funding required is RMB 150,000. Only one's relatives can act as his or her financial sponsor. The Statement should be accompanied by a scanned copy of the financial sponsor's valid passport or identification certificate (Self-supporting applicants should submit this statement).
 - ★ Graduation certificate and transcript should be notarized.
 - ★ The University will request for supplementary materials when necessary.
- ★ Application materials mentioned above will not be returned to applicants whether they are admitted or not.

- ★ Applicants can check the result of admission on SMU International Students Management System, and the *Admission Notice* with an official seal of SMU a will be sent afterwards.
- ★ Visa Application for Study in China (JW201/JW202) are fully electronic from 2023 onwards, and will be sent to the email address that the applicant has filled in on the application system. Please download it from your computer in time, as there are a total of 10 chances to download it.

The scholarship awardees' academic performance will be assessed each year and the result will be submitted to Chinese Scholarship Council. Students must pass the annual assessment for receiving the scholarship in the following year, or else the scholarship will be suspended or canceled.

IV. Scholarship Coverage and Standard

- 1. Exemption from tuition fee;
- 2. Accommodation on campus; Off-campus accommodation students who are permitted by the University can receive accommodation allowance each month;
- 3. Stipend: RMB 3,500 /month /person for Doctoral students, RMB 3,000 /month /person for Master's students and RMB 2,500/month/person for Undergraduate students;
 - 4. Comprehensive medical insurance.

V.Eligibility

- 2. Applicants should be physically and mentally healthy, and meet the medical examination standards for applying for a study visa or residence permit in China.
 - 3. Age Limit and Education Background Requirements:
- (1) Undergraduate students: under the age of 30, with a diploma comparable to the High School Diploma in China..
- (2) Master's students: under the age of 35, with a degree comparable to the Bachelor's Degree in Chinese universities.
- (3) Doctoral students: under the age of 40, with a degree comparable to the Master's Degree in Chinese universities.
- (4) General Scholar: under the age of 45, with a degree comparable to the Bachelor's Degree in Chinese universities.
- (5) Senior Scholar: under the age of 50, with a degree comparable to the Master's Degree in Chinese universities.
- 4. Applicants should be friendly to China, with excellent grades and good conduct, without any record of violation of school rules and regulations, nor any record of public security punishment or criminal record.

- 5. Applicants should have excellent grades and clear purpose of studying in China, with a GPA of 3.0 or above in the previous academic year without failing or repeated subjects.
 - 6. Language Proficiency Requirements:

(1) Master's /Doctoral Programs

Chinese Medium Program: Applicants must reach a score above 180 in HSK 5 or provide other comparable certificates proving Chinese proficiency. English Medium Program: Applicants from non-English-speaking countries must reach a score above 90 in TOEFL (20 or above for each item) or 6.5 in IELTS (6.0 or above for each item); or provide other comparable certificates proving English proficiency. Applicants from English-speaking countries or receiving the last degree with the instruction in English are exempt from submitting the English proficiency certificates, but the certificate of English medium issued by the school graduated from shall be provided.

★ Applicants for professional Master's Degree (General Scholars) in Clinical Medicine (1051), Dentistry (1052), Traditional Chinese Medicine (1057), and Nursing (1054) are required to provide a certificate of 180 points or above in HSK Level 5 (inclusive) or equivalent Chinese language proficiency upon admission. Graduation thesis must be written in Chinese (English translation version can be attached). For specific majors, please refer to Master's Degree (Professional) / General Scholars Programs of 2024 Degree Programs for International Master's /Doctoral Students (Visiting Scholars) of Southern Medical University.

★ Applicants for academic Doctoral/Master's Degree (Senior Scholars) in Clinical Medicine (1002) and Dentistry (1003) are required to provide a certificate of 180 points or above in HSK Level 4 (inclusive) or equivalent Chinese language proficiency upon admission. For specific majors, please refer to Doctoral/Master's Degree (Academic) / Visiting Scholars Programs of 2024 Degree Programs for International Master's /Doctoral Students (Visiting Scholars) of Southern Medical University.

(2) Undergraduate's Programs (Chinese Medium)


Applicants must reach a score above 180 in HSK 4 or provide other comparable certificates proving Chinese proficiency. Applicants receiving the last degree with the instruction in Chinese are exempt from submitting the Chinese proficiency certificates, but the certificate of Chinese medium issued by the school graduated from shall be provided.

Outstanding International Students Scholarship for Freshmen

The "Scholarship for International Students from Southern Medical University" is established for outstanding self-supporting international students, aiming to encourage international students with excellent academic performance to pursue their degrees at Southern Medical University. All outstanding international students are welcome to apply.

I. Category and Amount of Awards

- 1. Guangdong Government Outstanding International Students Scholarship for Freshmen
 - (1) Doctoral students: RMB 30,000 per person for one-time reward.
 - (2) Master's students: RMB 20,000 per person for one-time reward.
 - (3) Undergraduate students: RMB10,000 per person for one-time reward.
- 2. Southern Medical University President Scholarship for International Students

First Prize: Full scholarship, exemption from tuition fee and provided with stipend. The amount of stipend is as follows:

- (1) Doctoral students: RMB 2,500/month/person for 12 months.
- (2) Master's students: RMB 2,000/month/person for 12 months.
- (3) Undergraduate students: RMB 1,500/month/person for 12 months.

Second Prize: Partial scholarship with exemption from tuition fee.

Third Prize: Partial scholarship with half exemption from tuition fee.

Undergraduate students should score over 75 for all courses with no failure in senior high school study period.

- (1) Undergraduate students in Chinese Medium: Applicants must reach a score above 180 in HSK 4 or provide other comparable certificates proving Chinese proficiency. Applicants receiving the last degree with the instruction in Chinese are exempt from submitting the Chinese proficiency certificates, but the certificate of Chinese medium issued by the school graduated from shall be provided;
- (2) Undergraduate students in English Medium: Applicants from non-English-speaking countries must reach a score above 6.0 in IELTS (5.5 or above for each item) or 80 in TOEFL (15 or above for each item); or provide other comparable certificates proving English proficiency. Applicants from English-speaking countries or receiving the last degree through English medium are exempt from submitting the English proficiency certificates, but the certificate of English medium issued by the school graduated from shall be provided.

- (3) Master's /Doctoral students in Chinese Medium: Applicants must reach a score above 180 in HSK 5 or provide other comparable certificates proving Chinese proficiency. Applicants receiving the last degree with the instruction in Chinese are exempt from submitting the Chinese proficiency certificates, but the certificate of Chinese medium issued by the school graduated from shall be provided;
- (4) Master's /Doctoral students in English Medium: Applicants from non-English-speaking countries must reach a score above 6.5 in IELTS (6.0 or above for each item) or 90 in TOEFL (20 or above for each item); or provide other comparable certificates proving English proficiency. Applicants from English-speaking countries or receiving the last degree with the instruction in English are exempt from submitting the English proficiency certificates, but the certificate of English medium issued by the school graduated from shall be provided.
 - 6. Applicants do not receive the Chinese Government Scholarship.

2024 Admission Guide for Foundation Program of

Southern Medical University

In order to help students who apply for studying at Southern Medical University (SMU) to adapt to Chinese education system and teaching requirements, know more about SMU and programs, and also make full preparations for the undergraduate study, SMU offers a foundation program for international students. Through one semester or one year's foundation study, this program aims to enable international students to meet the entry requirements of SMU not only in Chinese and cross-cultural communication, but also related professional knowledge.

I. Admission Requirements

1. Applicants should be non-Chinese citizens holding a valid foreign passport.

If both parents or one of the parents of the applicant are Chinese citizens and reside in a foreign country, the applicant should have foreign nationality at birth and hold a valid foreign passport or nationality certificate for at least 4 years. In addition, a record of more than 2 years of actual residence in a foreign country in the last 4 years (by April 30, 2024) is also needed. For people immigrating from Chinese mainland, Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan to foreign countries and are applying as international students, please refer to the requirements above.

- 2. Applicants should be physically and mentally healthy, and meet the medical examination standards for applying for a study visa or residence permit in China.
 - 3. Applicants should be 18-30 years old with a high school diploma or above.
- 4. Language proficiency: Applicants from non-English-speaking countries must reach a score 5.5 in IELTS (5.0 or above for each item) or above 70 in TOEFL (12 or above for each item); or provide other comparable certificates proving English proficiency. Applicants from English-speaking countries or receiving the last degree with the instruction in English are exempt from submitting the English proficiency certificates, but the certificate of English medium issued by the school graduated from shall be provided.

II. Course Setting

The courses will focus on language teaching and take professional knowledge learning as an essential supplement. For language learning, it consists of Medical Chinese and common Chinese, which is going to be taught in accordance with the admission test results. While for the professional knowledge learning, mathematics, chemistry and biology are included.

One semester or one year



★ After receiving the Admission Notice and Short-term International Student's Information Form (DQ) or Visa Application for Study in China (JW202), applicants shall apply for Study Visa in China to the Chinese Embassy (Consulate General) and other visa agencies abroad with the following materials: Admission Notice, Visa Application for Study in China (JW202), the original copy and photocopy of Physical Examination Record for Foreigner and valid passport.

VIII. Admission Date

Students should register in March or September 2024, and the specific time shall be subject to the date marked on the *Admission Notice*.

★ Students admitted shall register at School of International Education with the original copies and scanned copies of the *Admission Notice*, *Visa Application for Study in China* (JW201/JW202), passport, certificate of physical examination and other relevant materials in accordance with the prescribed time on the *Admission Notice*. Students who cannot register on time due to certain reasons shall obtain prior consent of the University. Those who fail to register within the given time without approval will be regarded as waiver of registration.

Double room: RMB 4,500 /person/one semester; RMB 9,000 /person/academic year;

Triple room: RMB 2,500/person/one semester; RMB 5,000/person/academic year.

4. Other fees including textbook costs, board expenses, medical expenses, utility bills, drinking water charges, internet charges, medical insurance expenses, visa extension expenses etc. shall be paid

accordingly by the international students.
