

2023 Prospectus for Non-Degree Chinese Language Program of Yangtze University

Yangtze University (YU) is a multidisciplinary higher education institutions located in the famous historic and cultural city of Jingzhou, Hubei province, China. The campus covers an area of 3.1412 hectares, wherein 1.058 hectares are school building area, and the fixed assets are 3.294 billion yuan. Sports venues including gymnasiums, comprehensive training halls, swimming pools, football, tennis and other venues are all available. YU has 3 post-doctor stations, 15 PhD programs, 175 master's programs and 107 undergraduate programs covering 11 disciplines including economics, law, education, literature, history, science, engineering, agriculture, medicine, management and art. Furthermore, YU has the qualifications to recruit Chinese Government Scholarship students (CSC), and has a HSK (New Chinese Proficiency Test) test site.

By 2022, there are 3,196 teachers and administrative staff, and around 2,107 teachers with at least master degrees and 600 international students enrolled in 69 countries, including United States, France, Canada, Russia, Spain, Mexico, Chile, Colombia, Ukraine, Montenegro, Laos, Vietnam, Pakistan, Nepal, Zimbabwe, Ghana, Papua New Guinea and other countries.

I. WHO TO APPLY

Those who are interested in Chinese language and culture, or intend to study medical major but without HSK 4 Certificate can apply the 1-year Self-sponsored Non-Degree Chinese Language Program. Applicants must be non-Chinese citizens, below 25, at least hold an official high-school graduation certificate with decent grades, and should respect Chinese social customs & codes of conduct as well as abide by Chinese law and the regulations of YU.

II. WHEN TO APPLY

Applicants of either YU long-term programs or short-term programs should submit their application three months prior to the beginning of a new semester. However, special cases can be admitted any time.

III. HOW TO APPLY

Please visit <https://yangtzeu.at0086.cn/StuApplication/Login.aspx> to submit necessary materials. Admission will be determined after the verification and appraisal of the application materials. If applicants are admitted, they will receive a Visa Application Form for International Students to China (form JW202) and Admission Notice. With the two above mentioned documents, applicants can apply for their student visa (X1 or X2) at the Chinese embassy in their home country.

Step 1	Study more about the school and the programs of YU. Get university and program information and read details in our website before starting your application. Make a decision on which program and which degree you are going to apply for.
Step 2	Register in YU online application system. Upload necessary documents in YU online application system, including transcripts, application form(word format), passport, etc. <i>All documents should be scanned completely, clearly and colorful, otherwise the materials would be returned back for re-submit.</i>
Step 3	Get the admission notice. YU will send you admission notice to your email if your application documents are qualified.
Step 4	Pay the fee. Complete the application fee (CNY 800) in university bank account to keep you in the waiting list. Please send us the scanned copy of the receipt after payment.
Step 5	Get the result. Usually, it takes 3-4 weeks to get visa documents (JW 202 form) from the government after YU gets application fee in its bank account.
Step 6	Prepare for your travel to China. If you get all visa documents, you can prepare your visa application and flight booking. Please inform the admission office the details of your flights 7 days before your departure to China.

V. WHEN TO ENROLL

An academic year consists of spring and autumn semesters, the division of which follows the schedule of Chinese spring festival and varies from year to year. Autumn semester is from late August or early September to late January of the next year, while Spring semester is from late February or early March to mid-July.
