



Founded in 1951, Harbin Normal University is a high-level teaching and research-oriented university with a long history and a focus on teacher education. It is an important talent cultivation and scientific research base for education, arts, humanities, social sciences, and natural sciences in Heilongjiang Province. The university is a key institution under construction in Heilongjiang Province, an excellent university in undergraduate teaching evaluation by the Chinese Ministry of Education, a teacher training center for the international promotion of Chinese language in Heilongjiang Province, and a national Mandarin Testing Center. The university is one of the key institutions for the basic capacity-building of universities in central and western China and one of the 100 universities receiving key national support during the “13th Five-Year Plan” period. In December 2022, the university was selected as a domestic first-class university in the new round of “Provincial Double First-Class” construction projects in Heilongjiang Province.

The university is located in Harbin, the northern ice city of China, with three campuses on the south and north banks of the Songhua River, forming a “one school, three campuses” pattern. The university covers an area of 3.46 million square meters and has a building area of 1.639 million square meters. It has an exhibition center consisting of four integrated museums centered around the Wenbo Museum. The library holds more than 12 million volumes of documents and is a key protection unit for ancient books in China.

The university has 25 colleges (departments), offering 80 undergraduate majors, 104 master’s degree programs, 10 first-level doctoral degree programs (65 specialized fields), and six postdoctoral research stations. The university currently has 37,000 full-time undergraduate, master’s, and doctoral students.

The faculty at the university is strong, with more than 1,700 full-time teachers, including over 330 professors, over 660 associate professors, and over 600 doctoral and master’s degree supervisors. The university has more than 90 national outstanding talents, including experts in the “National Hundred, Thousand, and Ten Thousand Talents Project,” young and middle-aged experts with outstanding contributions, special allowance recipients from the State Council, national-level teaching masters, and national outstanding teachers.

The university actively carries out international cultural exchanges and cooperation. It has established educational, scientific, and technological cooperation and academic exchanges with 71 universities and research institutions in more than 20 countries and regions, including Russia, the United States, the United Kingdom, France, Japan, Canada, Australia, Poland, South Korea, Brazil, and Egypt. The university has jointly established the “Harbin Normal University International Academy of Fine Arts” with the Moscow State Surikov Art Institute, Russia. The university is also a recruiting institution for Chinese government scholarships, international Chinese teacher scholarships, and Heilongjiang provincial government scholarships, as well as a certification center for the “International Chinese Teacher Certificate” and a base for the Chinese Proficiency Test (HSK).

Since the launch of education for international students in China in 1984, the university has trained more than 13,000 international students from 66 countries and regions. Currently, the university receives more than 1,000 long-term and short-term international students annually. The university has three dedicated apartment buildings for international students, with a total building area of 23,000 square meters. The apartments offer single and double rooms, each with a private bathroom, and public facilities such as a gym, kitchen, and laundry room.

Note: 1. If the applicant was born in China, a certificate issued by a government department proving that they have joined the country for more than four years is required.
 2. Language requirements: Bachelor’s program applicants must pass the HSK Level 4 exam (excluding applicants for Chinese language study). Master’s and Ph.D. programs applicants must pass the HSK Level 5 exam.

VISA APPLICATION AND ENROLLMENT REGISTRATION

1. Accepted students should go to the Chinese embassy (consulate) in their country with their ordinary passport, "Admission Notice", "Visa Application Form for Foreign Students in China", "Physical Examination Record for Foreigners", and all original physical examination reports to apply for a study visa according to the embassy's requirements.
2. Incoming students must enter China with an ordinary passport and X visa and complete the residence permit application procedures within 30 days of entry.
3. Complete the enrollment registration procedures at the Foreign Student Management Office of Harbin Normal University according to the date specified in the "Admission Notice". Students who cannot return to the school on time should email lgb@hrbnu.edu.cn.
