1 Introduction to the University

Founded in 1965, Guizhou University of Traditional Chinese Medicine has been keeping the main educational concept “Development first, Quality foremost, Innovation subject and Training talents” as sustained educational aim. Our university motto is “Great virtue and firm determination, diligent learning and arduous practice”. It focuses on training high level talents in TCM area and aims to develop into a TCM University of relatively complete school-running level with high quality of medical treatment, education and research which gives priority to TCM and is supported by multidiscipline.

In 2004, it became a key supportive university in Guizhou Province. In 2007, it was rated as an “excellent” institution for the evaluation of undergraduate teaching work. Since 2016, it has become the university which supported by the State Administration of TCM and the Guizhou Provincial People’s Government collaboratively. It passed the undergraduate teaching review assessment of the Ministry of Education and passed Chinese medicine, Chinese pharmacy professional accreditation.

Guizhou University of TCM is located in Guiyang, the capital of Guizhou Province. It consisted of Jiaxiu campus and Huaxi campus, 15850 students at enrollment, including 1055 postgraduates and 14196 undergraduates. It has 16 secondary schools and teaching departments such as School of Basic Medicine, School of Pharmacy, etc. More than 10 research institutions (including Institute of TCM, Institute of Chinese Material Medical, Institute of Ethnic Medicine etc.), two affiliated hospitals, and No.1 Affiliated Hospital (also called Guizhou Hospital of Traditional Chinese Medicine) No.2 Affiliated Hospital (also called Guizhou Provincial Hospital of Integrated Traditional Chinese and Western Medicine). It has 26 clinical teaching and field training hospitals, 12 community medicine practice bases, 17 nursing practice bases and 54 non-medical training bases.

With our increasingly enhanced capabilities to conduct international academic exchanges, our university has been cooperating with a lot of countries in recent years, including France, Britain, Germany, Australia, Korea, Singapore and Thailand etc. For example, we have cooperated with British universities in terms of Academic education of pharmaceutical preparations. Furthermore, supported by the Ministry of Education, we have established the National 2011 Collaborative and Innovation Center and the International Collaboration and Joint Laboratory for Guizhou’s Ethnic Medicine, which helps our university standing out even more in terms of international exchanges among other universities.

Academic Education Master's degree candidate		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Applicants should be eighteen (18) years old or above, as of 31 August 2022; With a relevant professional bachelor degree or above; Be on the straight, with physical health, stable financial support and under custody; Those with Chinese HSK level 5 or up.
Non-academic Education (Chinese language) Visiting Students		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> The age of the applicant should be 18-22 years old Those with Chinese HSK level 2 or up; Be on the straight, with physical health, stable financial support and under custody.

3 Accommodation and fees

4 How to Apply

4.1 Submission of application for admission

Register and upload relevant information from the International Student Information System of Guizhou University of Traditional Chinese Medicine website: gyctcm.at0086.cn/student. The uploaded materials include but are not limited to (for language other than Chinese, please provide Chinese translation documents):

- i. Scanned passport (if already in China, also need a copy of the visa page);
- ii. Previous stage diploma and transcript;
- iii. Personal Resume Form;
- iv. Foreigner Physical Examination Form;
- v. Applicants for diploma programs also need to provide HSK Level 5 certificates;
- vi. No criminal record certificate.

4.2 Qualification examination

After receiving the application, our International Exchange and Cooperation Department will check the applicant's admission qualification in a timely manner and you will be informed as soon as we obtain the audit results.

4.3 Issuance of Letter of Admission

After the qualification examination is completed, International Exchange and Cooperation Department will send an Admission Letter for Overseas Students in Guizhou University of Traditional Chinese Medicine and Visa Application for Study in China (JW202).

4.4 To handle China visa

The applicant shall taking the private passport, photo, the Admission Letter for Overseas Students in Guizhou University of Traditional Chinese Medicine, Visa application form for study in China (see Form JW202) and the Physical Examination Record of Foreigner with him/her to apply to China's embassies and consulates to the local for China visa in person. For those whose period of schooling is shorter than 180 days, they can apply for visa X2; while, in case that longer than 180 days, visa X1 can be applied for.

4.5 Enrollment and Registration

You shall hold your own Admission Letter for Overseas Students of Guizhou University of Traditional Chinese Medicine to register in International Exchange and Cooperation Department of our University within the required time. Furthermore, you also shall deal with relevant formalities in the local Public Security Bureau of Exit and Entry Administration within 24 hours after arriving at school.

5.2 Scholarship of Guizhou University of Traditional Chinese Medicine

The University set up 4 levels scholarships for foreign students. School does not offer scholarships in any form for short-term projects.

i. First-class scholarship: exemption of tuition and accommodation fees for one academic year;

ii. Second-class scholarship: exemption of tuition fee for one academic year;

iii. Third-class scholarship: exemption of 50% tuition fee for one academic year;

iv. Fourth-class scholarship: exemption of accommodation fee for one academic year.
