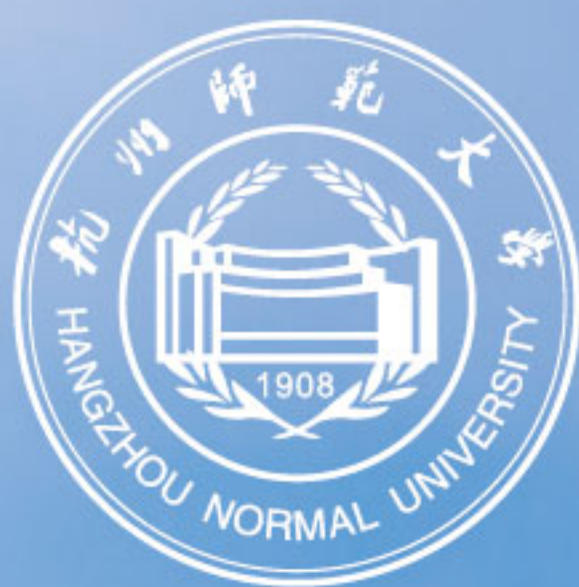

A Brief Introduction of Hangzhou Normal University

Hangzhou Normal University started as Zhejiang Official Dual-Level Normal School in 1908. It was renamed Zhejiang Provincial First Normal School in 1913. In the turbulent early 20th century, the School was open to modern education and emerged as a pioneer of the development of democracy and science in China. In 1978, Hangzhou Teachers College was formed on the basis of Hangzhou Normal School. At the turn of the 21st century, multiple institutions were successively integrated into Hangzhou Teachers College. 2007 witnessed the expansion of Hangzhou Teachers College into Hangzhou Normal University (HZNU).

With 24 schools, and 2 affiliated hospital, HZNU consists of Cangqian, Xiasha and Yuhuangshan campuses, covering a total area of about 229 hectares, with a total construction area of 2.29 million square meters. It has 3118 staff members and more than 32,000 full-time students, including over 6,000 graduate students, and about 450 international degree students.

With 14 of its disciplines in the top 1% of international ESI disciplines, HZNU is now among China's top 100 by ESI ranking; liberal arts and sciences are among the strong disciplines. There are 8 Bachelor Programs, 10 Master Programs, and 2 Doctoral Programs open to international students in 2025.

HZNU keeps pace with the Belt and Road Initiative and follows closely what is going on globally. The University, which is among the first to be accredited by China Education Association for international education, co-runs a center for Chinese language education in partnership with Middle Tennessee State University in the United States, a Joint Institute with Kharkiv National University in Ukraine and a Joint Program at Master Level with the University of Canberra in Australia. Exchange programs have been established with over 70 renowned universities around the world, confirming that openness and inclusiveness should be the key to the development of HZNU.

Chinese Government Scholarship

It is granted by the Chinese government for international students who study in the institutions of higher education in China. There are 6 types of the scholarship: undergraduates, graduate students, doctoral students, students involving in Chinese language and culture studies, students involving in general studies and advanced-level studies. Chinese Government Scholarship is classified into full scholarship and partial scholarship.

International Chinese Language Teachers Scholarship

Set up by China's Center For Language Education and Cooperation and granted to international students from Confucius Institutes worldwide who show excellence in their studies of Chinese language and culture. Applications can be made through the Confucius Institutes of the applicants' home country.

Zhejiang Provincial Government Scholarship

Set up by Zhejiang Provincial Government and granted to international students who excel in their studies at the university .

Hangzhou Municipal Government Scholarship

Set up by Hangzhou Municipal Government and granted to international students who excel in their studies at the university.

Hangzhou Normal University Scholarship

Set up by Hangzhou Normal University and granted to international students who excel in their studies at the university.



Medical Insurance

It is stipulated by Ministry of Education of China that all international students should have medical insurance while they study in China. Those with no valid insurance must buy insurance from Chinese insurance companies before registration.

Accommodation

There are different types of accommodation facilities for international students on campus. There are individual bathrooms, public kitchens and laundry, as well as cable TV, refrigerators, air conditioners, Wi-Fi service in all the rooms. Daily management and services are run by professional staff.

Application Requirements



Basic Requirements:

Applicants must be non-Chinese citizens, aged 18 and above and in good health, holding valid passports and willing to abide by China’s laws and the university’s rules and regulations and show due respect to China’s social and cultural customs.

Language Proficiency Requirement:

Degree Program in Chinese: Undergraduate, HSK Level 4, Score 210 and above;
Graduate, HSK Level 5, Score 180 and above;

Degree Program in English: English Language Proficiency evaluation mainly depends on interview;

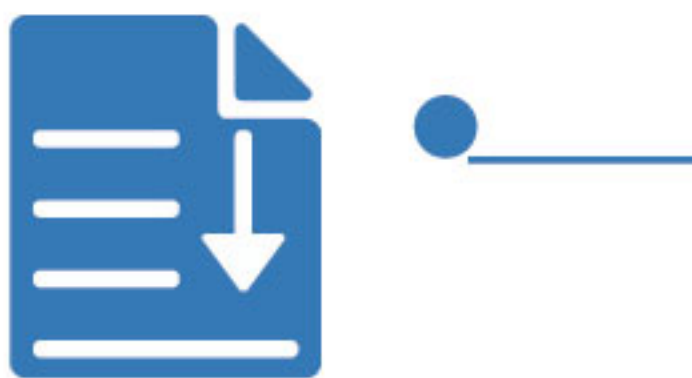
2. Graduate Programs

- 2.2 Official transcript for all the courses during Bachelor’s/Master’s degree study;
- 2.3 Two letters of recommendation from full professors or associate professors;

Other documents (in Chinese/English)

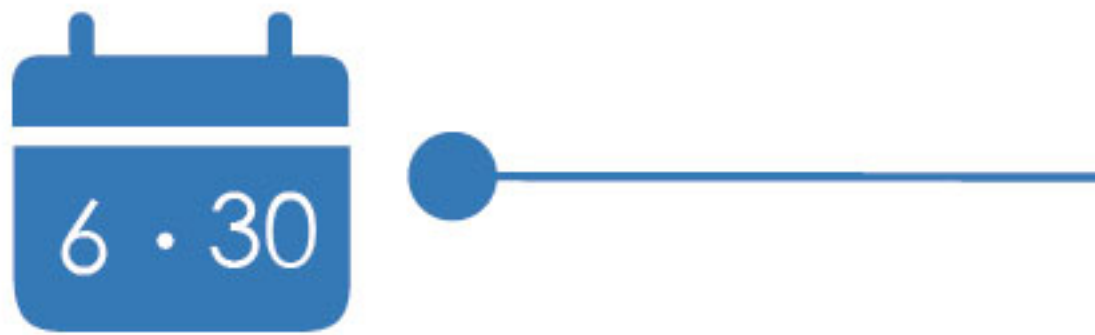
- 1. A photocopy of passport;
- 2. Scanned file of 2-inch photo;
- 3. Non-criminal Certificate;
- 4. Foreigner’s Physical Examination Report (please attach Chest X-ray report and blood test reports);
- 5. Self-introduction Video (within 2 minutes);
- 6. Personal Statement (including study plan, no less than 800 words);

Application Procedures

- 2. Register an account;
- 3. Fill in application information correctly;
- 4. Upload the required documents completely;
- 5. Save and Submit;
- 6. Check the application result (the admission process normally takes 20 business days);
