ADMISSION GUIDE FOR Chinese Government Scholarship High Level Postgraduate Program

Admission and Registration



1. Document Review.

JZMU will have an initial review of the applicant's identity, educational background, language ability, health condition and non-criminal record, etc;

2. Supervisor interview.

The applicant who passed the document review, the relevant teaching school/department of JZMU will conduct an academic interview for applicants to comprehensively assess their academic background, scientific research ability, potential attitude towards study in China and language proficiency;

3. Pre-admission.

A pre-admission letter will be issued to the qualified applicants after Supervisor's interview and then the pre-admission letter will be uploaded to CSC online application system;

4. Final Admission.

CSC will review the qualifications and application documents of candidates nominated by JZMU, and decide on the final list of scholarship winners, then JZMU will send Admission Letter and Visa Application Form for Study in China (JW201) to scholarship recipients;

5. Registration.

In early September annually (please refer to Admission Letter). Applicants shall register at JZMU within the stipulated time with all original application materials after receiving the admission letter. Those who are unable to register punctually and without approval of deferred registration by JZMU will be deemed as giving up the admission and the scholarship will not be retained.

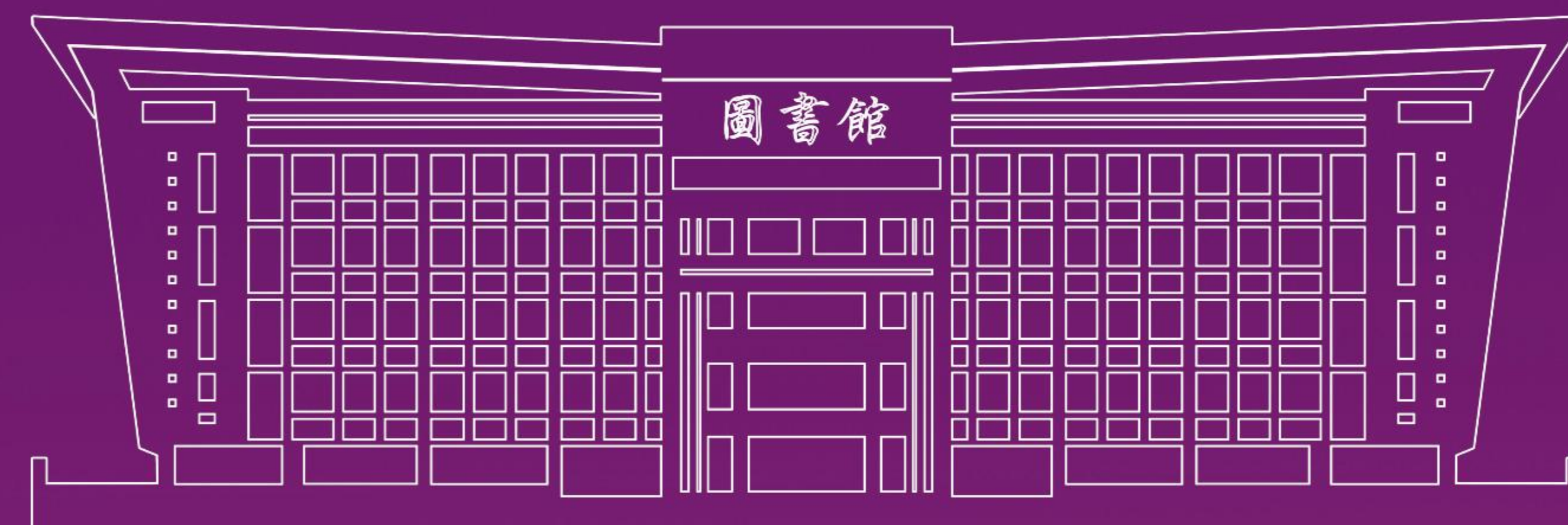


Notification

1. Applicants who have emigrated abroad and acquired foreign nationality must hold a valid foreign passport or nationality certificate for 4 years or more, and have more than 2 years of residence in a foreign country during this period (The actual residence in a foreign country for more than 9 months in a year can be calculated as one year, subject to the entry and exit stamps);

2. Chinese Government Scholarship students are not allowed to take any other scholarships established by the Chinese government and JZMU;

3. Applicants for the Master's Professional Degree in Clinical Medicine (MBBS) must have an HSK (Level 4) certificate.

The “High Level Postgraduate Program” of Chinese Government Scholarship (hereinafter referred to as “High Level Program”) aims to train international medical students to become qualified scientific clinicians with excellent academic capabilities, solid clinical skills and future creative potentials.

Jinzhou Medical University (hereinafter referred to as “JZMU”) is an institution qualified to admit Chinese Government Scholarship applicants approved by the Ministry of Education China.

The China Scholarship Council (hereinafter referred to as “CSC”), entrusted by Ministry of Education of China, is responsible for the admission, enrollment and administration of Chinese Government Scholarship recipients. CSC website <http://www.campuschina.org>.

Categories and Duration

Postgraduates (Masters): 3 years.

Scholarship Coverage

Full scholarship covers tuition, accommodation, comprehensive medical insurance and living allowance.

Eligibility

An applicant should meet the criteria below

1. Non-Chinese citizen with a valid ordinary passport;
2. Good health both mentally and physically;
3. Non-criminal record;
4. A Bachelor's degree holder and under the age of 40. A bachelor' degree in Clinical Medicine(MBBS) is necessarily required for the applicant of Clinical Medicine programs;
5. Language Eligibility

5.1 Chinese-taught Programs: applicants shall have the certificate of HSK Level 4, or those who have obtained a degree from a Chinese university using Chinese as the language of instruction are exempt from providing HSK score report;

5.2 English-taught Programs: applicants shall obtain a minimum score of 6.0 in Academic IELTS (each of the four areas≥ 5.0) or 70 in TOEFL (each of the four areas≥15). Applicants whose first or official language is English or who have taken a degree program taught in English are exempt from providing the above certificate of English proficiency.

Application Document

1. Application form for Chinese Government Scholarship (to be filled online <https://studyinchina.csc.edu.cn/#/login>);

2. A scanned copy of Passport Information Page. The passport should not expire on or before September 1st, 2026. Please renew the passport if the requirement is not met;

3. Notarized highest diploma. Applicants who have not graduated by the time of application are required to provide an official letter from the current university stating the expected date of graduation;

4. Academic transcripts. Copies of academic records from first to last semester during the undergraduate program. Transcripts shall be issued and sealed by the attending university's relevant department;

5. Certificate of language proficiency. Applicants applying for Chinese-taught program shall provide valid HSK (Level 4) score reports. When applying for an English-taught program, applicants should provide valid English proficiency certificates (TOEFL 70+/IELTS 6.0+);

6. Pre-Admission Letter issued by the International Education College of JZMU shall be signed;

7. A study plan proposal. A study plan shall contain not less than 1000 words or characters;

8. Two recommendation letters from professors or associate professors. These letters shall describe the applicant's objectives of learning in China, comprehensive abilities, and evaluation of future growth (signature and contact information are necessary);

9. Photocopy of the Foreigner Physical Examination Form completed in English (the original copy shall be kept by the applicant). The form is designed by the Chinese quarantine authority. The physical examinations must cover all the items listed in the Foreigner Physical Examination Form. Incomplete records or those without the signature of the attending physician, the official stamp of the hospital, or a sealed photograph of the applicants are invalid. Please select the appropriate time to take a physical examination as the result is valid for only 6 months;

10. Non-criminal record report. The applicant shall submit a valid certificate of Non-Criminal Record issued by the local public security authority, usually issued within 6 months prior to the submission date of the application;

11. Other supporting documents (e.g. certificates of work or internship, award, publications, etc.).

■ Please note:

All documents must be uploaded in an English version. Please ensure your non-English documents have been translated by an authorized translation agency. Both the original and translated documents must be uploaded to the application system simultaneously. Uploaded supporting documents must be clear, authentic and valid. Applicants shall bear the consequences caused by unclear or unidentifiable uploaded materials.

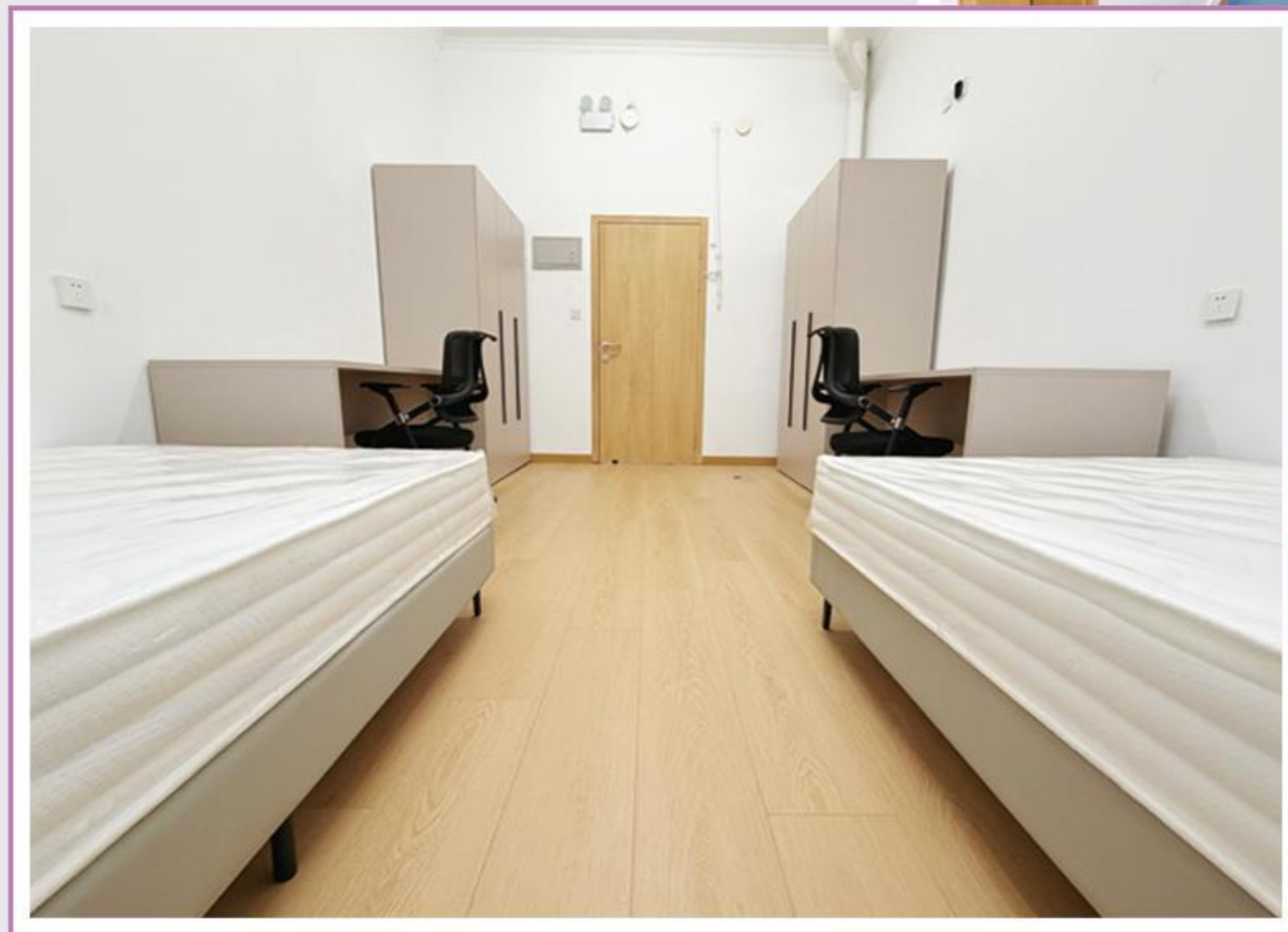
How to apply

1. Create an account. Please carefully read the Application Documents above, visit “CSC Study in China” website and click “Scholarship Application for Students” at <http://www.campuschina.org>. Register an account through [CREATE AN ACCOUNT] and log in with your account;

2. Input Personal Details. Click “Edit Personal Details” and finish inputting personal details by filling in all the information, verifying and saving the information. After the completion of this section, return to the previous page by clicking “Finish” and start filling in your application information;

3. Select the correct “Program Category”. Please select Program Category “Type B”, click “New Application”, and start filling in the application information;

4. Enter the correct “Acceptance institution Number (provided by the intended university)”. Your agency number is: 10160. The “Type of Study Program” and “Acceptance Institution Number” are interrelated and both are mandatory fields in the “Chinese Government Scholarship Management Information System for Studying in China”. After the applicant completes the form, the system will automatically display the name of the accepting department represented by the filled-in code. There is a corresponding relationship between the type of study program and the acceptance institution number. If filled in incorrectly, the scholarship acceptance department will not receive the online application information;



5. Fill in the “Application Information”. After completing the above steps, enter the “Language Proficiency and Study Plan” and upload the “Supplementary Materials” until you click “Submit” to complete the application. Before submitting the application, please carefully review all the information and supplementary materials, ensuring their accuracy and authenticity;

6. Once the application is submitted, the applicant cannot modify the “Personal Information” and “Application Information”. Before the application is processed, the applicant can click “Withdraw” to retract the submitted application and make modifications. After withdrawal, the applicant must resubmit the edited application; otherwise, it will not be processed. Once the application is accepted, the applicant cannot withdraw it;

7. Click “Print Application” to download the application form;

8. Submit the scholarship application according to the requirements of the receiving institution.

1. Please use Firefox or Internet Explorer (11.0);
2. For applicants using Internet Explorer, please close the “compatible view mode” function ahead of editing;
3. Please fill in all application information in Chinese or English;
4. Scholarship-awarded universities shall not entrust any individual or intermediary agent to process Chinese Government Scholarship applications. All designated institutions shall inform applicants of accessing relevant information on the official website of the China Scholarship Council (<http://www.campuschina.org>).
