




# ABOUT HKUST(GZ)

Formally established in June 2022, the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (Guangzhou) (HKUST(GZ)) is a cooperatively-run university between the Chinese mainland and the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region. HKUST(GZ) has obtained approval from the Ministry of Education (MoE) and become the first legally-independent educational institution co-established by the Mainland and Hong Kong since the announcement and implementation of the "Outline Development Plan for the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area" and the "Overall Plan for Deepening Globally Oriented Comprehensive Co-operation amongst Guangdong, Hong Kong and Macao in Nansha of Guangzhou". With a spirit of pioneering innovation, HKUST(GZ) charts new territories in cross-disciplinary education and explores new frontiers in pedagogies, aiming to serve as a role model of the mainland-Hong Kong integrated educational development and become a world-famous high-level university, endeavoring to nurture future-oriented, high-level and innovative talents.


# 🛐 ABOUT RED BIRD MPHIL PROGRAM (RBM)

The College of Future Technology (CFT) Red Bird MPhil Program (also known as RBM) is the first step in our university's commitment to promoting the integration of the "Hub-Thrust Concept". It aims to cultivate "top talents and future leaders in academia and industry". Students in RBM have the opportunity, based on their personal interests, educational background, and future career plans, to engage in independent academic exploration within the first six months of enrollment. During this time, students define their research direction, select their collaborative team and academic supervisors (through mutual agreement), and subsequently register in the Thrust Area of their academic supervisors upon approval. RBM places a strong emphasis on student-centered learning. Through a teaching model guided by team projects, students collaborate with academic supervisors from various Thrusts, project supervisors, or industry supervisors to collectively complete team-based projects.

### **MULTIPLE ADMISSION MECHANISM**

The RBM breaks away from the traditional admission mechanism of categorizing applicants by discipline. It does not limit applicants by their fields of study. Through an "Individual Application-Committee Review" process, the program recruits outstanding candidates globally, on a rolling basis, and selects the best out of best. The main channels for admission include:

### 1. Application-Review Mechanism

Applicants submit their applications through the official website and successfully go through several stages, including a preliminary screening using a grading system, manual review by committee, and an offline interview. Exceptional candidates will be granted admission by the Selection & Interview Committee.

### 2. Red Bird Challenge Camp

Applicants submit their applications and successfully go through the selection process for the Red Bird Challenge Camp, an official program organized by HKUST(GZ). Camp participate who perform exceptionally well and pass the selection and interview conducted by the Selection & Interview Committee will be granted admission.

#### 3. Recommendation-Review Mechanism

Applicants recommended by academic institutions recognized by HKUST(GZ) (currently limited to the Guangzhou University, which is in collaboration with The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology) will directly enter the interview stage. Candidates who successfully pass the interview conducted by the Selection & Interview Committee will be granted admission.

### 4. Nomination-Admission Mechanism

Applicants nominated by overseas partner universities will be granted direct admission after being reviewed by the Selection and Interview Committee.

### **General Admission Requirements**

#### Degree Admission Requirements

Obtained a bachelor's degree from a recognized institution, or an approved equivalent qualification.

#### English Language Admission Requirements

Applicants have to fulfill English Language requirements with one of the following proficiency attainments:

- **▼** TOEFL-iBT: 80\*
- **▼** TOEFL-pBT: 550
- ☑ TOEFL-Revised paper-delivered test: 60 (total scores for Reading, Listening and Writing sections)
- ☑ IELTS (Academic Module): Overall score: 6.5 and All sub-score: 5.5\*

#### Applicants are not required to present TOEFL or IELTS score if

Their first language is English, or obtained the bachelor's degree (or equivalent) from an institution where the medium of instruction was English, or obtained a master's degree (or above) from an institution where the medium of instruction was English.

#### **Further Study**

- 58% graduates have chosen to continue their studies.
- **83** graduates have chosen to continue their studies domestically such as Tsinghua University, Fudan University and the HKUST(GZ), etc.
- **46** graduates from the class of 2024 have chosen to study abroad such as the Stanford University, Cambridge University, ETH Zurich, University of Melbourne, University of Sydney, University of Hong Kong, Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, etc. And the regions where these graduates are heading primarily include Hong Kong, the United States, Australia, and other locations.

### **Employment**

**26%** graduates have chosen employment and key employers are Huawei, Tencent, BYD, Bank of China (Hong Kong) Limited, TP - Link, NIO, Anheuser - Busch InBev, HKUST(GZ) and various enterprises and institutions across different industries.

## 📆 STUDY IN CHINA, GUANGZHOU

The Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area (Greater Bay Area) comprises the two Special Administrative Regions of Hong Kong and Macao, and the nine municipalities of Guangzhou, Shenzhen, Zhuhai, Foshan, Huizhou, Dongguan, Zhongshan, Jiangmen and Zhaoqing in Guangdong Province. The total area is around 56 000 km<sup>2</sup>. Based on the latest figures provided by the Guangdong Province, the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Government (SARG) and the Macao SARG, the total population in the Greater Bay Area is over 87 million and the GDP is over RMB 14.5 trillion in 2024.

The development of the Greater Bay Area is accorded the status of key strategic planning in the country's development blueprint, having great significance in the country's implementation of innovation-driven development and commitment to reform and opening-up. The objectives are to further deepen cooperation amongst Guangdong, Hong Kong and Macao, fully leverage the composite advantages of the three places, facilitate in-depth integration within the region, and promote coordinated regional economic development, with a view to developing an international first-class bay area ideal for living, working and travelling.

### Life in Guangzhou

Guangzhou, also known as Canton, Yangcheng and flower city, is the capital of Guangdong Province in southern China. It is one of the most populous and vibrant cities in China, with a rich history dating back over 2,200 years. As a major port and trading hub, Guangzhou has long been an important center of commerce and cultural exchange. Guangzhou is a modern metropolis with a booming economy and a thriving manufacturing and trading industry. It serves as a crucial transportation hub, connecting China to the rest of the world through its international airport and extensive railway network. Guangzhou, located in the Pearl River Delta, has a climate shaped by both oceanic and continental influences. Nestled between the Nanling Mountains and the South China Sea, it experiences average annual temperatures of 21.7°C to 23.1°C.



### **Campus Location**

In order to foster true and meaningful collaboration between the two campuses, the 1.1-sq-km Guangzhou campus is conveniently located in Nansha, south of Guangzhou and adjacent to the Qingsheng station on the high-speed Guangzhou-Shenzhen-Hong Kong Express Rail Link. It takes just 30 minutes to travel there from the Hong Kong West Kowloon railway station.




